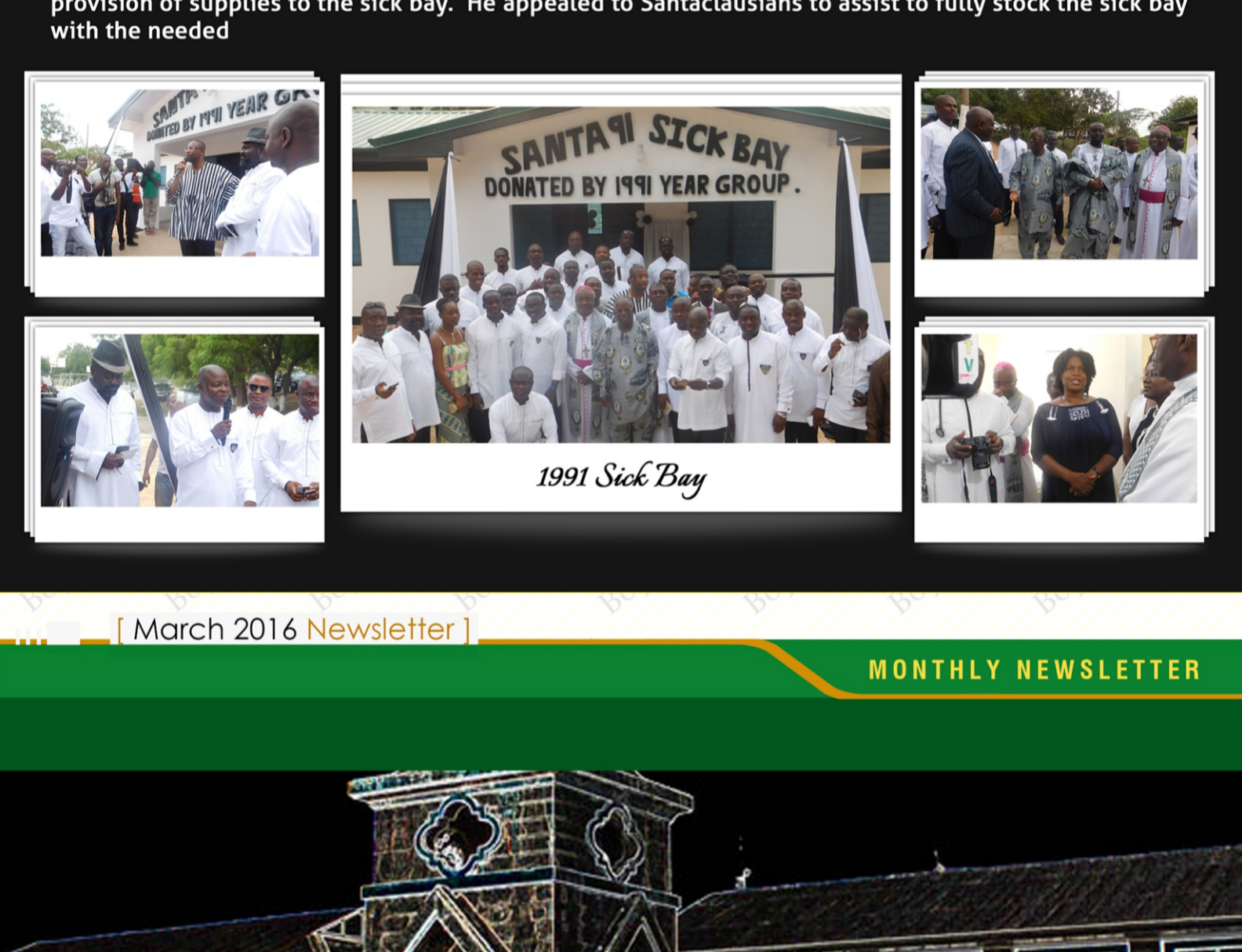

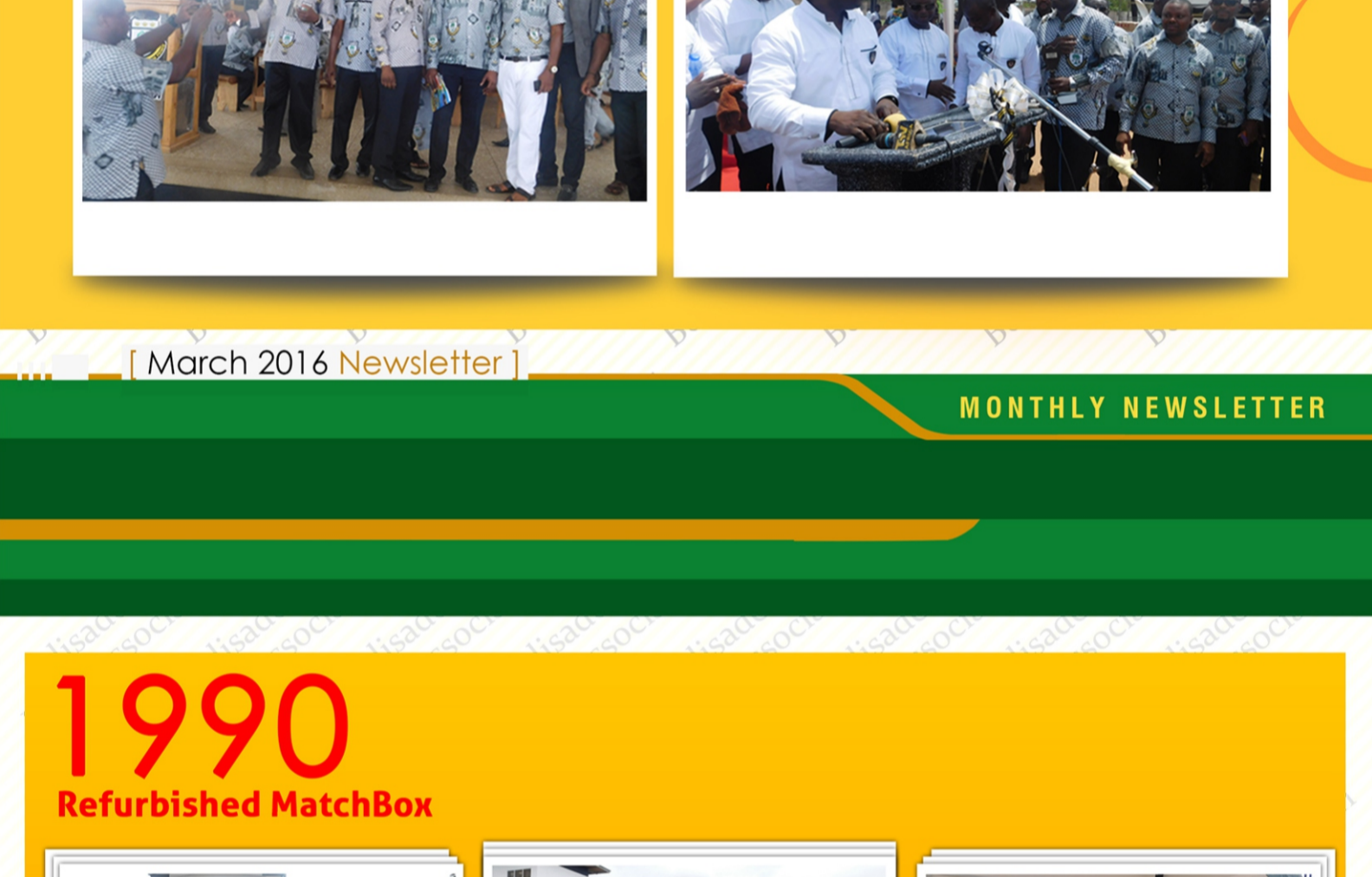


1991 SICK BAY

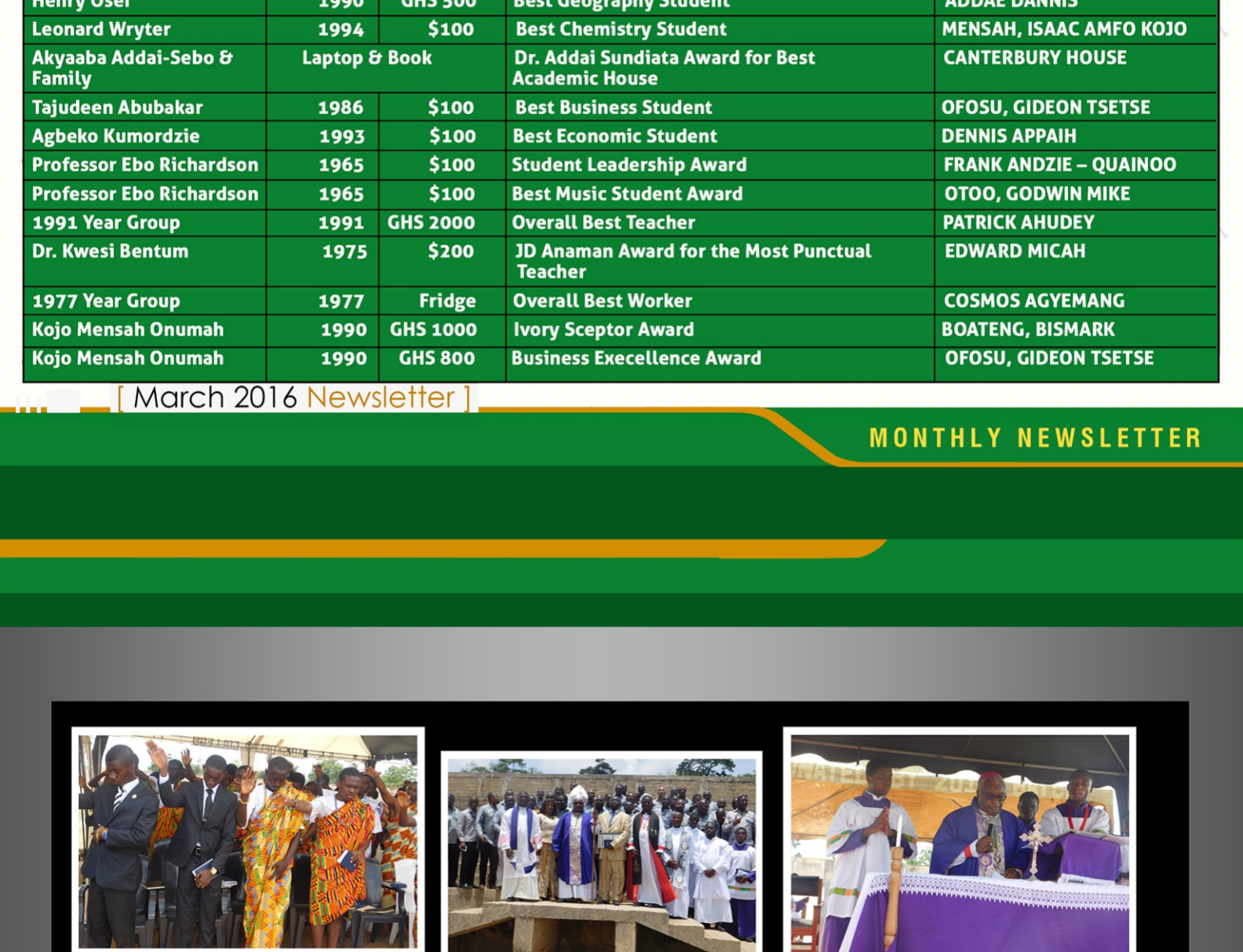

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA BY NEC

The criteria and requirements stated below will be strictly adhered to by the Committee in charge of admissions. All Old Boys who wish to have their wards admitted to the college are to submit the following to the NEC secretariat.

1. Name of Sponsoring Old Boy
2. Year of Completion
3. Name of Ward
4. Results slip
5. List of Schools chosen
6. Evidence of Energy group participation (to be provided by Energy group President). The following criteria will be used by the NEC during the selection and consideration stage:

1. Admission is limited to wards of Old Boys only (Grand children will be considered, friends and other family relations not included)
2. Your ward must have chosen Adisadel as his first choice
3. Your ward must have an aggregate score of between 6 and 12.
4. Submit the name of your ward and results slip to the NEC secretariat by the deadline to be given.
5. You must be an active member of your energy group (Year Group President must certify).
6. Your Energy/Year group must have fully met their obligations to the NEC.

7. Your year group must provide a letter to the NEC to support your application.
8. Consideration will be given to Old Boys who contribute to the welfare of the college through the NEC.
9. Special consideration will be given to Old Boys who assist NEC Financially.
10. Your financial Obligations to the Association must have been met (Dues and Projects especially Fencing). Kindly contact Solomon on +233208210713 for clarification. Kindly note that Old Boys admission will be through the NEC. Please DO NOT contact the Headmaster.
